

All Saints Day is on Friday 1 November this year, and our service on Sunday 3 November will be on this theme. We hope you will come and join us.


At 6.30pm on the same day we have a Eucharist service in the chancel, to which you are also invited.

# ECO TALK IN THE VILLAGE HALL – MAKING OUR HOMES SUSTAINABLE

We had a really entertaining and informative talk from Neil Peters in October. The third talk of this Autumn series will be on Thursday 14 November from 7.30pm to 9pm in the Alan West Room of the Village Hall.

This will be full of information and guidance on how to make your home more sustainable, including reducing the level of

fossil fuels used by retrofitting improved insulation, exploring solar energy and storing it in batteries and more. It will be given by Community Engagement advisors from Ovesco with Howard Johnson from OneZero, who will give encouraging and up-to-date information. There will be the usual refreshments during the informal last half hour. The talks are free but donations are really helpful to ensure we cover costs involved.

### RINGMER REPAIR CAFÉ

The Steering Group reports that Kings Academy Ringmer and the Parish Council have agreed that the Repair Café can be held in the Council office area for no charge, which is hugely supportive.

While we have a few new repairers lined up, we still need more. Please don't hesitate to get involved, particularly if you are good at electrical and electronic repairs. The financials are in hand and an application for grant funding is being made to provide a cushion for initial costs.

### ST MARY'S ECO TIP - RECYCLE YOUR COFFEE PODS

A lot of people have a coffee pod machine at home. The coffee pods are made from aluminium, in order to protect the freshness, taste and quality of the coffee. Aluminium is infinitely recyclable and 75% of all aluminium ever produced is still in use today, according to the European Aluminium Association. But they do need to be recycled, not thrown away. To do this you need a special bag, which you can order free online. When you have filled it, you can arrange collection by Royal Mail direct from your door, or drop it off at one of 14,000 Royal Mail locations, of which there are three in Lewes. In some areas there is a Podback Kerbside collection service - enter your postcode at https://www.podback.org/recycle-checker After collection, the coffee pods are taken to a specialist reprocessing plant in the UK to separate the packaging from the coffee grounds. The coffee grounds are used to create soil improver and renewable energy, while the plastic and aluminium is transformed into new products.

The Trust works to improve this through initiatives such as the removal of barriers to enhance fish passage, creating urban wetlands and introducing sustainable drainage. 

### WHAT'S ON IN RINGMER



The October Planning Applications Committee considered the Thakeham2 proposal for 95 new homes. Just

one Councillor supported, but no coherent grounds for refusal were agreed. The decision was deferred, which is likely partly to do with the substantial turnout of Ringmer residents so thank you to all involved. Two other applications were heard at the same meeting and, without opposition to equally inappropriate proposals, were passed.

There is still no news about the revised Local Plan – when we know, so will you. We understand that Catesby Estates have reluctantly agreed to meet Ringmer Parish Council and we'll report on that as soon as we can. Please keep on with your protests and don't forget you can get a free DON'T URBANISE RINGMER placard. Any evidence of opposition may just persuade developers to find easier targets elsewhere. ### RINGMER VILLAGE HALL NEWS

Thanks to all who came along to our celebration of 50 years of the Jack Hart Hall, which was lovely. It was nice to celebrate both the anniversary and the recent refurbishment.

On Saturday 30 November, we're holding one of our popular Souper Saturday lunchtimes from 12pm until 2pm. This is a great occasion to meet old friends for a tasty but economical lunch while raising funds for the Village Hall. The Parish Council will be holding their Neighbourhood Plan event at the same time as an added attraction!

The Village Hall electricity bills have more than tripled over the last few years, and we expect insurance to rise due to the flood claim, so it will be a struggle to balance next year's budget. Regrettably, hire charges for 2025 will increase by just under 5%, and a new small business rate is being introduced. In setting these rates, we remain highly competitive and still offer excellent value for money. Please can all users do their part by turning off lights and shutting windows and doors.

Security remains an issue so please be certain that all doors are locked when leaving - if necessary wait for the door to swing shut and check the lock has engaged.

Lastly, we have reduced the price of our Village Hall Christmas cards to £2.50 per pack of 10 – they are available at the library, and we are keen to sell out – grab a bargain!

### WILDFLOWER RINGMER | LAUGHTON GREENWOODS



### WILDFLOWER RINGMER

This peacock butterfly photo was captured in the Almond Field by naturalist and Ringmer resident John Luck, who has volunteered to undertake regular surveys. We are pleased that Ringmer Parish Council has agreed to trial a less harsh mowing regime for parts of the Village Green from next year. By reducing the mowing frequency and raising the

mower blades we hope to develop a flower-rich grass sward. This change is in line with the Council's Biodiversity Policy. Plantlife (the wild plant charity) recommends mowing grass every four weeks, cutting to a height of 3-5cm. Some flowers will be cut off during mowing but as part of the plant lies beneath the mower blades cutting will stimulate the plants to put out more flowers. The wildflowers that will benefit include bird's foot-trefoil (feeds over 130 insects, bumblebee favourite Selfheal and nectar-producing red and white clover. The wildflower area on Sadlers Way Green has been fenced off. Established wildflower species – cowslips, oxeye daisies and violets – are still there but much of the grass has been removed. We have sown a wildflower seed mix which includes 44 wildflower species and native grasses - can't wait to see the results next year! ### RINGMER PARISH COUNCIL



**REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY –** The parade on 10 November starts with Lewes, Glynde & Beddingham Brass Band leaving the car park behind the shops at 10.45am, via Springett Avenue and Lewes Road to the War Memorial. The maroon will sound at 11am followed by a two minute silence and then the Reveille. The names of the fallen will be read followed by prayers and a church service from 11.15am after which the parade will reform and march back to the car park.

**IMPROVING THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT IN THE VILLAGE** - The Almond Field officially opened on 15 October complete with access path, two benches and many wildflowers that have been planted to increase biodiversity. The field was donated by the late Bill Almond who lived in Ringmer with his wife Anne for many years. It has been accepted by the Southdowns National Park Authority (SDNPA) as a Call for Nature site and it provides a quiet reflective space for Ringmer residents to enjoy. Find it at the back of the new churchyard on the left just next to the entry to the Mutton Field.

RINGMER JUBILEE COTTAGES HOUSING TRUST – To add to the two cottages on The Broyle donated by Ian Askew in 1977 to offer Ringmer families low rent accommodation for up to three years, the Trust reports the purchase of a third property. Blyth Cottage is at 51 Shepherds Way and was bought with the aid of a bequest from Linda Blyth and CIL funding. The new tenants moved in last month.

SWIMMING POOL UPDATE – ESCC Chief Operating Officer Ros Parker told LDC Cllr Johnny Denis that the lease is back in the hands of the District Council and that, while the funds are in place, the LDC needs to finalise the lease asap.

### **DISTRICT COUNCILLOR UPDATES**

Councillor Emily O'Brien says: "At the last full council a motion was unanimously passed calling on Government to address the housing crisis by focusing on increasing the amount of social housing (for example, scrapping the right to buy) rather than deregulation of the planning system and creating conditions which make it impossible for councils in more rural areas to maintain an up-to-date Local Plan. We adopted 'new homes principles' at the last cabinet meeting which helpful set out our approach to our own council house building programme. Locally I'm concerned, like the Parish Council, about the Thakeham 2 development and spoke against it at planning committee. I continue to chase Southern Water on behalf of residents of Green Close who are dealing with sewage flooding their gardens. Southern Water are also digging their heels in over allowing for a connection that would enable the solution to garden flooding in Mill Road which worsened following the Caburn Field development, which is deeply frustrating when then there is a solution on the table, and I'm looking into how we can apply pressure on that."

### **HONOURING RINGMER'S HOLM OAK 1938-2024**

Ringmer's Holm Oak stood for 86 years. Its beauty and grandeur became a focal point not only of the Green, but also for the village itself. A source of pride and solidity, its roots reaching deep beneath the surface of the Green, the Holm Oak weathered storms, saw the passing of decades and generations, shaded children playing, became home for endless squirrels and birds and offered a sense of permanence and beauty in an increasingly chaotic world.



The Holm Oak was planted in 1938 by Rev. Arthur Robinson, John Christie and his children, Rosamond and George [above] and, sadly, split and collapsed earlier this summer. Last month, the Holm Oak was removed and the site cleared.

### RINGMER PAST TIMES



Continuing the series of old photographs of Ringmer, courtesy of Ringmer History Group.

This photograph, probably taken about 1910, shows John Goldsmith's grocer's, tobacconist's and confectioner's shop, opposite the Green. Parked nearby are his delivery carts, one a handcart and the other horse-drawn. The field gate marks the position of today's twitten through to Shelley Road. The

Georgian house, originally a residence, is mathematically tiled and was first recorded in 1793. The Goldsmith family continued to run the shop, later called the Central Stores, into the 1960s. It is now called Cheyney House. On the edge of the Village Green, opposite, is a heap of broken flints, used by the council roadman to keep the main road, not yet asphalted, in good condition. It cannot have been a great surface for cycling on, so the bicycle wheels parked near the shop entrance were perhaps awaiting repair.


